Veteran dog.1 (2)

1. Brindle and white dog. Stood alone. Well balanced head, kind, expressive dark eye, wide nostrils and wide straight bite. pleasing front assembly, round bone and tight feet. Nicely laid back shoulder and spring of rib, level topline leading to well angulated quarters, moved well and enjoyed his day. BVIS.

MPD 6 (2)

1. Brown & Hutchings Walk It Talk It. Elegant brindle and white, just 6 months, lovely clean head, well placed ears, dark expressive eye, defined stop, broadwide nostrils, well padded muzzle, correct wide straight mouth. Crested neck leading to well laid shoulder, nice depth of brisket, level top line, well angulated quarters which he really uses to power around the ring, excellent movement for one so young. Very stylish, BPD

2. Beardsell & Van-Beck Interrogating Newlathie, another lovely puppy dog. Well grown dark brindle, slightly bigger than 1. Correct rise of skull, beautiful expression, dark eye, well defined stop. Evident forechest, well laid back shoulder depth of brisket and well off for bone. Nice tailset, well angulated quarters with good width of second thigh, presents a square profile. Moved well just preferred mouth of 1
3rd Chipendale Carpenter Crooks Bynhafod Patrick Swayz at Mylicam

PD 2

1. Mc Carthy & Gething Boxania Romanoff To Jeddhi 10 month old puppy dog, Brindle and white, beautiful head, flat cheeks, well laid shoulder and short strong back, moved freely, lovely adult in the making.

2. K.Louis. Boxania Over The Moon, litter brother to 1, Balanced head, dark eye, well placed shoulders, topline and tailset, strong quarters moved well, difficult decision between one and two, I'm sure they will change places over the coming months as these youngsters develop.

JD. 3(1)

1. Loasby's Sashbob Double Oh Seven with Berwynfa. Pleasing head, dark eye well padded muzzle wide nostrils. Nice front with evident forechest, good bone, beautiful tight feet. Level topline and correct tailset, good rear angulation and well let down hocks, moved well.

2nd. Wood's Arkeney Conqueror Brindle dog, different in type to 1. Head still coming along, correct almond eye shape and large nostril, front angulation good, not as much forechest as 1, level topline slightly longer cast, movement was a bit erratic today.

Post Graduate Dog 6

1st Watson & Carpenter Crooks Roylark Boot Neck. Red and white dog, balanced dog, presenting a square, clean outline, in good condition. Clean skull, dark, expressive, tight eye dark pigmentation, evident stop, wide straight mouth and sweep of lower jaw, correct lip placement. Evident forechest, leading to well angulated shoulders and upper arm, catlike feet. Lovely depth of brisket, nice tuck up and short strong loin, bang on tail set, strong hammy quarters which moved him around the ring with ease. Well handled. BD and BIS

2nd Godwin's Sultash Prince of Hearts brindle and white in gleaming condition, Clean head with a dark eye, wide mouth. In profile this dog is slightly longer cast than 1. Clean balanced head, dark eye wide nares, clean neck leading to good withers, straight front, I would have just liked to see a little more forechest and front angulation. Level topline, and correct tailset, moved with purpose.

3rd Wooliss & Flintoft Boxania Roamin Around at Rameleon.

Limit Dog 5(2)

1. Littlewood and Bowler's Olleyville James Dean at Whirlobox. Brindle and white dog, well presented, Pleasing head, dark kind eye with an honest expression. Wide straight mouth, Deep chest and well laid shoulders, tight feet, good depth of brisket strong, level topline, short in loin good tailset, hammy quarters, moved well looks well in profile and did not disappoint going over. RBD

2. Renshaw -Turner & Turner & Murfin, Farvalley Dark Warrior Different in type to one. Not overly flashy but this dog has a lovely kind eye and expression, good wide mouth, front a little narrow, shoulder angulation adequate, tight feet, defined withers, deep brisket, slightly longer cast so he just didnt have the overall balance of 1.

3 Aimes, Marbelview Phantom Menace at Thenamy

Open Dog 4(1)

1 Littlewood & Bowler. Olleyville Stanleyman at Whirlobox Brindle and white boy, 6 years old, Balanced head, good rise of skull, wide deep well padded muzzle, tight dark eye, correct length of upper arm, tight feet, nice shoulder angulation, good depth of brisket and short coupling, quarters are well developed and hammy , kept his shape on the move.

2 Godwin's Sultash Cuncoe. Brindle and white boy, clean well proportioned head, with width and depth of muzzle, dark eye, wide mouth, good length of upper arm, and defined shoulder angulation, not quite as square in profile, slightly long cast, hammy quarters and well let down hocks, moved well.

3 Humphries Norwatch Sunhawk Good Time with Chribanna

Brown & Hutchings Winuwuk Silent Witness. Dark brindle and white, of six months, what a lovely puppy, lovely head in the making, dark eye full of expression, defined stop, broad nose with wide nares, straight front, feet tightening up, well angulated layback of shoulder and correct depth of brisket, she presents a lovely square balanced outline, correct tailset. Hammy quarters for such a baby, with well let down hocks. Moved out well for such a baby. BPB and BPIS

PB 3

1st Godwin's Sultash Charisma, 11 month old brindle and white, pretty headed baby in the making, clean skull, good rise, dark tight eye, very nice front with good layback of shoulder, crested neck which she used, while presenting a clean elegant outline. Level topline good tuckup, correct tailset, and hammy quarters, moved well for a youngster.

2nd Beardsell & Vann-Beck Newlaithe CID. 9 month old brindle and white bitch, presenting a square outline, pleasing head, dark eye, good stop & rise of skull, crested neck broad level topline, hammy quarters, used well on the move, lovely puppy with time on her side.

3rd.Flintoft's Boxania Make Me Smile.

JB 2(1)

Brown & Hutchings Winuwuk Private Affair Another lovely bitch, Clean head, good width and depth of muzzle, dark, tight eye. Crested neck, and well off for bone, tight feet, good depth of brisket, sweeping tuck up, good tailset, quarters are well angulated, hammy, and well developed. Moved and handled well.

YB 2(1)

1. Loasby's Twist N Pulse at Berwynfa. Dark brindle and white, Pretty head and expression, pleasing head proportions, good length of neck, slightly steep in shoulder, straight front and tight feet, good depth of brisket. Good tuck up slightly long cast, good tailset, good rear angulation, she just did not appear to be so well balanced today, which may be due to her eager bating.

PGB 4(3)

1. Beardsell & Vann-Beck's Nashville at Newlaithe Quality brindle and white bitch, presenting a square, balanced outline. Balanced head, wide deep muzzle, dark expressive eye, straight front, evident forechest, good shoulder angulation, tight feet, well developed withers, short coupled, strong hammy quarters and correct tailset, elegant, balanced girl RBBIS

2.Brown & Hutchings Love To Investigate at Winuwuk, ,Another lovely bitch. Balanced head, clean skull, beautiful expressive dark eye, wide nares, and wide bite. elegant neck, Brisket of good depth and short back just preferred the forehand of one.

3.Littlewood and Bowler Olleyville my Sweet Georgia at Whirlobox.

LB 4

1. Godwin's Sultash Enable. Dark brindle and white bitch, balanced head, dark eye, lovely inquisitive expression, good mouth, straight front and tight feet. Well laid back shoulder and evident forechest. Short level topline, good tailset, hammy quarters. Balanced outline. On her toes today and pushed hard in final line up for BBIS

2. McCarthy, Gething, and Banks, Sunhawk Norwatch Lovelace at Jeddhi. Dark kind eye, balanced head, good front and feet, deep brisket not quite as compact as one, good tailset and rear angulation.

3. Woods Kavanagh Arkeney Burns Night at Marbelton.

OB 1

Brown and Hutchings Winuwuk Aphrodite. Very smart brindle and white bitch, lovely balanced head and expressive dark eye, broad nose, wide nares, wide straight mouth and sweeping underjaw. Strong elegant neck and straight front, shoulders nicely angulated, good depth of brisket, level topline, and correct tailset. Quarters well angulated and well let down hocks, moved well.
