Veteran Dog 5 (2abs)

1st Mrs K Louis's Rameleon Nights In Harlem, 8 ¾ yr old Br/W. Balanced male with a clean square outline. Strong bone, good forehand with evident forechest, good spring to rib, short back and width to second thigh. Clean skull with correct muzzle to skull ratios, alert expression, evident chin and width to jaw. Moved with reach and drive. BVIS

2nd Mrs G Henderson's Taranut Stereotype, another balanced Br/W Male with a clean outline. Strong bone, cat like feet, well arched neck, correct angles fore and aft. Good clean skull, dark eyes, defined stop, evident chin and good mouth. Moved well.

3rd Miss M Littlewood & Mrs S Bowler's Olleyville Stanley Man At Whirlobox.

Minor Puppy Dog 8

1st J Brown & T Hutchings Winuwuk Walk It Talk IT AI, Br/W. Tall upstanding square male of almost 9mths, good bone with tight feet. Good length of neck, evident forechest with depth of brisket, good forehand assembly, slightly sloping topline with bang on tailset. His head still needs time but everything is in proportion, he has dark eyes, alert expression, clean skull without excess wrinkle. Moved with reach and drive.

2nd Misses L & S Mair's Sulez Scorch At Glenauld, Br/W 6mths. I really liked the head piece on this youngster, good muzzle to skull ratios, correct rise of skull, distinct stop, melting expression. Well arched neck, strong bone, good spring of rib, stroNg rear with good width of 2nd thigh, moves well. I preferred the shorter back of 1.

3rd G Pearce & D Francis' Longsdale Lets Get It On.

Puppy Dog 6

1st G Pearce, D Francis & C Kay's Seacrest Dios Diablo At Longsdale, Br/W. Smart outline with clean lines, cat like feet, short back and firm topline with correct tailset. Pleasing head with correct proportions, wide muzzle, open nostrils, evident chin, correct rise to skull. Dark eyes and appealing expression. Moved with drive.

2nd Mrs V A Van-Beck's In Terrogating Newlaithe, Br/W. Clean skull of correct proportions, good rise to skull, clean cheeks, would prefer a kinder eye. Good reach of neck, balanced angles, short back, spring to rib, moved well.

3rd Mrs C Chippendale & C Carpenter Crooks' Brynhafod Patrick Swayze At Mylicam.

Junior Dog 5 (1abs)

1st D McCarthy & S Gething's Boxania Romanoff To Jeddhi, Br/W. Eye catching male with a sharp clean outline. Good head with correct proportions, good mouth, clean cheeks, wide muzzle, evident chin, dark eyes and alert expression, evident stop, correct rise of skull free from excess wrinkle.

Parallel front, strong bone, cat like feet, good forechest and depth of chest. Arched neck leading into defined withers, well placed shoulders. Moved with good forward extension. Last 4 for CC.

2nd Misses L & S Mair's Macbarra Kickin Up A Storm At Glenauld, Br/W. Another equally smart youngster, good forehand assembly, strong bone, cat like feet, good depth to forechest, good length to neck, short back and firm topline with correct tailset, strong rear quarters. Moved well, Preferred the head on 1.

3rd Mr M Griffiths' Lanfrese Cartello.

Yearling Dog 4

1st Mrs P Taylor's Newlaithe Absolute Bug, Br/W. Super sharp clean outline, very good to get your hands on. Head of correct proportions, wide muzzle and evident chin, dark eyes and alert expression, evident stop, correct rise of skull. Parallel front, strong bone, good forechest and depth of chest. Arched neck leading into defined withers, well placed shoulders, firm topline, bang on tailset. Moved well showing reach and drive holding a level topline. Last 4 for CC.

2nd G R & M Seeney's Sulez Victorious At Maranseen, Br/W. Good head with correct proportions, good mouth, wide muzzle and evident chin, dark eyes and alert expression, big nose with open nostrils, correct rise of skull and free from excess wrinkle. A well put together dog with good angles both ends, moved with good reach and drive. I preferred the square outline of the winner.

3rd Mrs Ann Bee's Beeann Cover Story.

Novice Dog 4 (1abs)

1st G & L Brough's Limubox Helluva Fantasy, Br/W. Pleasing head with plenty chin, dark eyes of good shape, good ratio of muzzle to skull, clean cheeks, strong bone, cat like feet, good depth to chest and spring of rib. Well muscled rear. Would prefer a better turn of stifle to complete the picture.

2nd D F Neilson & R Connell's Borestone Secretariat, R/W. Caused some issues for his handler today, he has a clean skull but not the ratios of 1 however as he matures it will likely develop, cat like feet, short back, spring of rib and well muscled quarters, moved OK when not playing up.

3rd Y R Tonkin & K Pellow's Rosanyos Enigma.

Graduate Dog 2

1st Ken Woods' Arkeney Barrister, Br/W. Balanced profile, clean neck into well laid shoulders, short back, good width to second thigh. Pleasing head of correct proportions, clean skull, width to muzzle, evident chin, dark eye and alert expression. Moved true showing reach and drive while holding a level topline.

2nd Mrs L J Harvey's Harvin Nordic Mystery, Br/W. Strong head with excess wrinkle, evident forechest, strong bone, parallel front, cat like feet, sloping topline, would prefer more strength to the rear to balance the profile.

Post Graduate Dog 3 (1abs)

1st Mrs E Woolliss & Ms S Flintoft's Boxania Roamin' Around At Rameleon, Br/W. Balanced male who has matured in body and strengthened in rear, he now poses a very pleasing picture. He has a smart square masculine profile, good front assembly, strong bone, cat like feet, correct depth to forechest, good length to neck, short back, spring to ribs and firm topline with correct tailset. Good head with

correct proportions, wide muzzle, open nostrils, evident chin, correct rise to skull. Dark eyes, appealing expression and good wide mouth. Moved with good forward extension. DCC

2nd Mrs F Godwin's Sultash Prince Of Hearts, Br/W. Lovely head piece, clean with correct ratios, flat cheeks, good mouth and beautiful expression. Well balanced male with good angles fore and aft, not always at one with handler on the move but when they did he moved well.

Limit Dog 13 (6abs)

1st P Keenan & D Griffin's Duxsara Double Diamond Br/W, Typical head, good width to muzzle and rise to skull, dark eye and good mouth, good angles fore and aft, parallel front, strong bone, cat like feet and spring of rib, hammy quarters and short hocks. He covers the ground well showing reach and drive.

2nd Ken Wood's Arkeney Adventurer Br/W. Different in stature to 1 but another honest male. Pleasing head, good width to muzzle, evident chin, correct bite, distinct stop, good rise of skull and alert expression. Good forechest, strong bone, tight feet, good depth to brisket and spring of rib, short back.

3rd Mrs L & Mr P Lafferty's Geenawell Lorenzo.

Open Dog 6 (2abs)

Quality Class.

1st Mr M Griffiths' CH Lanfrese Argento Br/W. Pleasing head with correct proportions, wide muzzle, open nostrils, evident chin, correct rise to skull. Dark eyes and appealing expression. Medium sized square profile with good balance. Well arched neck flowing smoothly into withers, good forehand. Parallel front, strong bone, depth of brisket, short back with strong firm topline and correct tailset. Good rear angulation with good width of thigh and short hocks. Moves well in profile. RCC

2nd G L Brough & J Cairns' CH Galicar Investigating With Limubox Br/W. Well balanced outline with clean lines and strong bone. Good muzzle to skull ratio, clean skull, alert expression, flat cheeks, correct width of muzzle and lip placement, good mouth and evident chin. Good angles fore and aft, cat like feet, parallel front, spring of rib and well muscled rear. Moved very well from all angles.

3rd Mr C Humphries' Norwatch Sunhawk Good Time With Chribanna.
