Class 1 Veteran Dog 2 1ab

1st Beardsell & Van-Beck's Newlaithe the Fugitive

Brindle square outline, with enough neck, dark eye of a good shape, and correct head proportions. Moderate angles front and back, nice tight feet, he moved with drive, and held his tail high.

Class 2 Minor Puppy dog 3-2ab

1st Huxley's Blixen Roland Garros

A tall brindle needing to drop in to his rear angles a little. The beginnings of a nice head, with a dark expressive eye. He was a good shape, and held his topline, slightly weak in pasterns, but time is on his side, he moved ok.

Class 3 Puppy Dog ... no entries

Class 4 Junior Dog 3-2ab

1st Beardsell & Van-Beck Newlaithe Super Natural

Brindle with a square outline, typical head, good mouth, correct neck length, good topline, needs to drop in chest a little, nice tight feet. Moved ok

Class 5 Yearling Dog 2-2ab

Class 6 Novice Dog 4-4ab

Class 7 P Grad Dog 4-2ab

1st Beardsell&Van=Beck's Newlaithe suited and Booted

Brindle with a square outline, clean head with a dark correctly shaped eye, correct neck length, coming in to a good topline, enough bone, and nice tight feet. He moved well, driving from the rear, and carrying his tail

correctly, pleased to award him best dog, and reserve best in show.

2nd Payne's Daervlish Ordinary Love at Birleyvale

Dark brindle, bigger boy all round than one, pleasing head, would have liked a tiny bit more length of neck, correct angles front and rear, moved well, but tended to double track a tad.

Class 8 Limit Dog 4-3ab

1st Beardsell & Van-Beck's Newlaithe Diddle On

Brindle good shape, with correct topline, and a correct length of neck, his angles were good, and he had a correct drop of chest. Dark eye, and nice rise of scull, could have had a tiny bit more width of muzzle.

Moved ok. Reserve best dog .

Class 9 Open Dog 4-3ab

1st Brooks Jimmy Coo at Jinnybrux

Sturdy red, who held his topline, rear angles were ok but I would have liked a little more lay of shoulder.

Dark eye, and enough muzzle width. He moved well if a little erratic.

Class 10 Veteran Bitch 2-1ab

1st Clayforth's Sunvalley Touching Wood with Tyslee

Brindle who was totally square, her head was clean, with good infill under her dark expressive eyes, enough neck length, correct amount of bone, good angles, tight feet, and moved true coming and going, nothing exaggerated, an honest Boxer with little to fault . RBB

Class 11 Minor puppy bitch 8-5ab

1st Drinkwater's Sulez Smasher

Brindle baby who suits her name ! .. smart girl, with the makings of a nice head, dark eye, and good rise, correct neck length, into moderate shoulders, lovely tight feet and she moved well. Pleased to award her BPIS .

2nd Wood's Marbelton Joint venture with Marbelton

Red , not as good in shoulder lay as one, and her ribs need to spring, Her head is coming along nicely, she was a good shape and moved ok

3rd Law and Pynegar Berwynfa Que Sera Sera

Puppy bitch 1 .. 1 ab

Class 13 Junior bitch 5 1-ab

1st Brown & Hutchings Winuwuk Aphrodite

Brindle , lovely head, with dark expressive eyes, correct neck length, into moderate shoulder lay, correct topline, and good angles at the rear, moved well .

2nd Beardsell & Van-Beck Nashville at Newlaithe

Nice head, good rise of scull, dark eye, but would like a better shape, correct topline, ok angles and moved well

3rd Payne's Boxania Romin away to Birleyvale

Class 14 Yearling Bitch 4 -2ab

1st Brown & Hutchings Love to Investigate at Winuwuk

Brindle of quality all through, and definitely one for the future, smashing head, with a lovely dark eye, good neck length in to a correct topline, correct lay of shoulder and rear angles, she moved well.

2nd Law's Shellark Rule the World

Brindle , slightly longer cast than 1, but a lovely bitch with a correct head, dark eye, that moved well

Class 15 Novice bitch 5-2ab

1st Payne's Birleyvale Bellisario

Brindle good make and shape, correct neck length, topline and tail set, lovely head with a dark eye of correct shape, tight feet, and she moved well

2nd McCarthy & Gething's Jeddhi Firefly

Brindle who had a beautiful head, correct dark eye, and good neck in to a strong correct topline. Angles where good front and back, lost out to one on leg length.

3rd Kavanagh's Arkeney burns night at Marbelton

Class 16 Post grad bitch 5-3ab

1st Drinkwater's Sules Livingdoll

Brindle with a beautiful head, correct dark eye, of good shape, correct neck length, topline and tail set, good tight feet, she wasn't moving 100% which I put down to the floor .

2nd Beardsell & Van-Beck's Newlaithe Purroco

Brindle Correct head, dark eye, but would prefer a better shape, not as long in leg as one, moved ok

Class 17 Limit bitch 4-2ab

1st McCarthy Gething & Banks Sunhawk Norwatch
Lovelace at Jeddhi

Brindle Lovely headed bitch, with a dark expressive eye, good infill, and correct shape. Correct strong neck coming in to a correct topline, with good shoulder lay, correct spring of rib, and rear angles, moved with reach and drive, pleased to award her BB and BIS

2nd Brook's Jacintabox just amazing by Jinnybrux

Brindle correct head, but would like a little more infill under her eye, ok neck length, and good topline, I would have liked a slightly better lay back of shoulder .

Class 18 Open Bitch 3-3ab
