I would like to thank the Committee, exhibitors and stewards; Steve and Mo Myring; for an enjoyable day. Some excellent dogs went cardless, I was very pleased with all my winners. Dogs in Limit and Open were first class, it was an honour to judge such super classes. Mouths are still a problem – far too narrow. On one or two exhibits the bottom lip curled over the bottom teeth.. Movement in all class winners was excellent.

Veteran Dog (4:1A)

1. Feaver & Cormack's Very Attracted to Newlaithe – Hard to believe he is in the veteran class. Super head and expression, lovely reach of neck, excellent shoulders and topline. Strong rear quarters which gave him that powerful movement. Credit to his owners for keeping him in such good hard condition.
2. Jink's Sulez Soul Man at Stangard – B/W 10 year old in excellent condition, well balanced head, lovely kind expression, true front and topline. Firm rear quarters, moved positive. Enjoying his day out.

Minor Puppy Dog (6:2A)

1. Duffy's Redmol Joe Black –B/W – Clean balanced head, dark expressive eyes, good rise of skull, correct depth and width of muzzle. The right reach of neck. Top line and feet needs to tighten up. Would like to see him in 6 months time; at the moment he is very raw.
2. Griffiths' Lanfrese Galoubet – B/W – Well balanced head, lovely expression, excellent body shape, but needs to tighten up feet, front and rear same as No 1, still very raw.

Puppy Dog (11:2A)

1. Drinkwater's Winuwuk Kiss Tag with Sulez – B/W – Outstanding puppy, excels in head, dark expressive eyes; has the correct width and depth of muzzle. Super reach of neck, well laid shoulders, right length of upper arm. Firm rear quarters. Smart moving puppy dog. Best Puppy in Show
2. Kelly's Casemates Dumbledore – R/W Quality puppy, clean balanced head, dark expressive eyes and expression. I liked the body shape, lovely arched neck, super outline, strong firm rear quarters. Pushed No 1 hard. Will change places over the coming shows in the future.

Junior Dog (7:1A)

1. Cook & Postance's Let Me Go To Manic –B/W – Lovely balanced head, right length and depth of muzzle, strong jaw with correct bite. Excellent front and forechest. Topline firm, strong rear quarters. Movement - strode out with powerful drive. Super class, outstanding junior dog. All dogs placed in this class on their day will change positions.
2. Huckerby & Dowell's Struck Via Norwilbeck Bellchime – B/W – Super headed dog, right balance, dark expressive eyes, clean front, strong boned limbs. Tight feet, correct depth of chest, Movement – holds his shape going round.
3. McArdle's Wildax Lookin Good at McArmadale

Yearling Dog (8:2A)

1. Pynegar & Murray's Berwynfa's Veni Vidi Vici JW- B/W – Excels in head, right depth and width of muzzle. Super wide jaw, dentition is good with right bite. Lovely dark eyes , strong forechest, well laid shoulders, top line and tail set. Powerful moving dog.
2. McArdle's Redmol Read All About It At McArmadale JW – B/W – Liked his head, correct depth and width of muzzle. Gives the right balance. Dark pigmentation, expressive eyes. Super reach of neck, well laid shoulders and topline. Firm rear quarters. Excellent moving dog.
3. Taylor's Newlaithe Leonardo

Novice Dog (7:1A)

1. Miller's Walkon First Among Equals – B/W – Dog of medium size, right balanced head, good depth and width of muzzle, expression excellent. Very alert and showy. Strong front and topline. Moved with drive.
2. Elsworth's Misstricks Stand and Deliver – B/W Head very much to type. Good outline, firm rear quarters with right angulation. Movement correct coming forwards.
3. Jones & Charles's Outta Sight at Charlons

Graduate Dog (8:2A)

1. Bell's Surfstone No Nonsense – B/W – Powerful dog of great substance. I loved his head, wide jaw, correct bite, dark expressive eyes. Excellent front, strong well laid shoulders. Powerful quarters drove him round the ring.
2. Laidlaw & Stockton's Roamaro Choccywoccydoodah For Kiztok JW – B/W – Super head with the right balance; dark eyes, strong muzzle, elegant neck and shoulders. Straight front, tight feet. Firm rear quarters, sound moving dog. Not the outline of No 1.
3. James's Bosckoph Dynamo

Post Graduate (14:2A)

1. Cherry's Cherryforge Botticelli – B/W dog of quality – super head, strong bottom jaw, correct length of neck, excellent front and tight feet. Strong topline and well laid shoulders, firm rear quarters. Sound moving dog. Just had the edge over No 2.
2. Morison's Xandene's It's In The Bag – B/W dog – clean balanced head, excellent stop, would like a little more length of neck. Super front and feet, firm quarters, moved soundly. A lot to like about him.
3. Revill's Verdendo Country N' Western

Limit Dog (14:2A)

1. Pynegar & Murray's Berwynfa Fully Loaded JW –Super well made dog of substance and quality. Good head with balance and expression. Lovely length of neck and shoulders. Excellent front and topline. Strong boned legs and quarters. Free striding dog. Pleased to award him Reserve CC.
2. Griffiths' Lanfrese Ocolardo – Loved his head and expression with the right length and depth of muzzle. Clean neck, firm topline. Rear quarters are well muscled. Ground covering stride. Pushed No 1 close.
3. Banks & Miller's Walkon Hey No Issue at Sunhawk Norwatch

Open Dog (11:2A)

1. Griffiths & Miller's Ch Walkon Okay Dokay with Lanfrese – Super dog of class and quality. Liked that alert expression of that " I am ready to go". Super head, good rise of skull, strong muzzle, right length of neck. Excellent shoulders and topline. Super straight limbs, lovely

tight feet, strong firm back. Strongly muscled quarters. Powerful moving dog. Pleased to award him Dog CC. On Referee nod he went Best in Show.

2. Groves & Hare's Jimbren Star Attraction – Striking B/W dog, excellent head and expression, lovely dark eyes, super front, correct reach of neck. Good topline, firm rear quarters. Sound moving dog.
3. Jones' Ch Kevanor Federer JW
